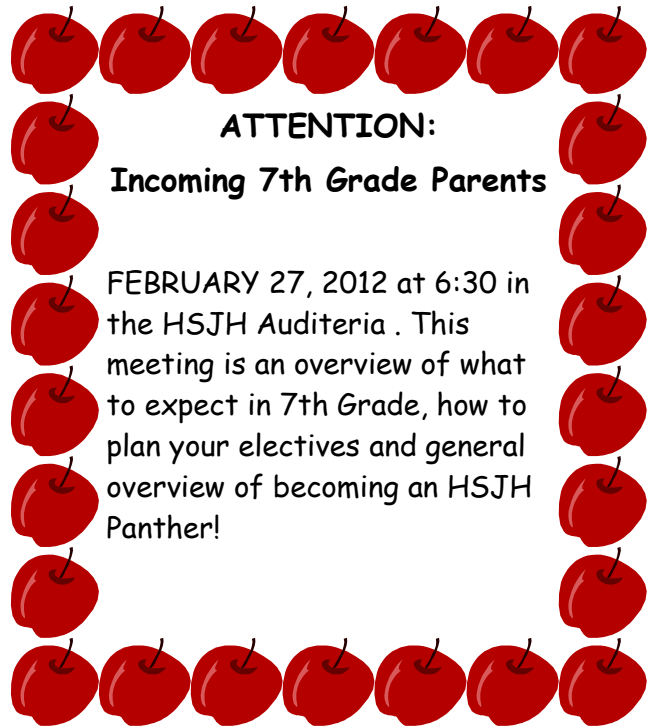


ISTEP TESTING
