

iPad Setup Basics

Initial iPad Setup Process

Directions for one iPad model follow. Different models and iOS versions may have slightly different screens, button locations, and selections.

Push and hold Sleep/Wake button (top right edge of iPad) until Apple icon appears on screen.

Hello. Press home button (bottom center button)

Choose English.

Choose United States.

Select wifi network by tapping on its name.

Enter username & password.

Tap join, Trust, and wait for the check mark to appear next to the wifi choice indicating connectivity.

Tap Enable Location Services. (This is one piece that makes *Find My iPad* functional.)

Choose setup as new iPad.

Tap next.

Hamilton Southeastern Schools will automatically configure your iPad screen,

Enrollment Credentials are needed > enter username & password, Next

Installing Configuration from Hamilton Southeastern Schools

Touch ID (this option is on some devices)>Set up Touch ID later>Continue

Passcode if desired

Apple ID>Enter Apple ID>Password

Terms and Conditions> Agree

Siri>Continue, if given that option.

IPad Analytics>Tap Don't Share. (There is not a need to send diagnostics to Apple on rented devices.)

Tap Get Started.

Other things to know...

Turn ON Find My iPad

This feature assists in finding a lost iPad. If this feature is not enabled, there is a significantly lower chance of locating a missing iPad.

Tap the Settings icon.

Tap iCloud on left menu.

Sign in with your Apple ID. (This is the same as your iTunes account).

If offered, choose OK to allow iCloud to use the location of your iPad.

If Find my iPad is off, tap to turn on.

Turn OFF Bluetooth

Disabling Bluetooth capability helps with keeping the battery charged longer.

Tap the Settings icon.

Tap Bluetooth on left menu.

Tap the On/Off button to show Off.

Name the iPad

Naming the iPad will be of assistance in locating a lost rented iPad. It's easier to find a named iPad than an unnamed one. Please remember what name is associated with your iPad.

Tap the Settings icon.

Tap General on left.

Tap About on right.

Tap Name.

Name the iPad with full student or parent name.

Sign into iTunes/App Store

If this was not done during setup, the sign in process can be completed here.

Tap the Settings icon.

Tap iTunes & App Stores on left.

Complete sign in process.

IOS Updates

Updates will be indicated in the Settings app and should be done when available at home, please.

Tap Settings.

Tap General on left.

Tap Software update on right.

Download and Install as needed.

Adding Apps

Installation of apps will be done with the family/student account and should be installed at home.

Tap App Store icon.

Search for app with search bar in the upper right corner.

Tap free or price button.

Tap install app.

Sign in if prompted.

Redeem gift cards by tapping Redeem button on the bottom center of App Store screen.

Load purchased apps from other iTunes accounts by signing in with THAT account, tapping Purchased from the bottom-center of the app store screen, and loading them.
