ANNOUNCEMENT/CAP & GOWN/ORDERS: Each senior should plan to order their graduation cap and gown and graduation announcements on Thursday, November 16th. Orders will be taken from 7:30 a.m. until 6:30 p.m. in the College & Career (CCA) commons area.

Graduation announcements ordered on November 16th will be available for pickup on Tuesday, March 13, 2018 in the CCA commons area.

Commencement: Saturday, June 2nd — The Indiana Farmers Coliseum at the Indiana State Fairgrounds @ 10:00 a.m. FHS students must arrive at the Coliseum and be in the **Youth Arena by 9:00 a.m.** Parking will be available for students and guests for \$5.00 per vehicle (cash or credit will be accepted). There are ADA parking spaces available in the Communications Building Lot; the Swine Barn Lot; as well as the Midway Lot. Please follow the directions of the parking staff to the nearest ADA parking area if needed. There is also an ADA (handicap) guest drop-off area just outside the main entrance of the Coliseum in the plaza on the north side of the building.

Graduating students should enter the main entrance of the Coliseum on the north of side of the building and report to the Youth Arena.

Parents, and all other guests need to enter through the main entrance as well and proceed directly to their seats. There are no assigned seats. All seating is on a first come basis.

Handicapped (ADA) seating will be available in the designated ADA areas. ADA seating is located at the top of sections 200, 202, 206, 209, and 216 off of the Main Concourse, as well as sections 300 and 302 off of the North Deck (3rd Floor). All 3 floors are elevator-accessible. Each person requiring ADA seating will be allowed one companion to remain with them during the commencement ceremony.

*Student Dress Code: For ladies, a dress is suitable, and for gentlemen, a shirt, tie and dress pants is appropriate. No flip-flops, shorts, tennis shoes, or jeans permitted. Seniors wearing inappropriate attire will not be allowed to participate in graduation.

After commencement has concluded, students and parents will reunite outside of the Coliseum.

***Please remember to wear your FHS medallion that will be given to you at commencement rehearsal.**

Mission Graduation/Senior Celebration: Saturday night June 2nd—Fishers High School Café A and Auxiliary Gym 9:00 p.m.—11:00 p.m. Mission Graduation tickets will be sold during lunches for \$10. The dates for ticket sales will be announced during student announcements. Look for detailed information in forthcoming newsletters or in the FHS weekly newsletter.

Senior Service Hours:

Seniors at FHS have the opportunity to earn a special cord to wear at graduation if he or she completes 15 hours of community service by April 30, 2018. Community service (or volunteerism) is defined as “the policy or practice of volunteering one’s time or talents for charitable, educational, or other worthwhile activities in one’s community.”

If you need assistance in finding opportunities for community service, stop by the guidance department to pick up this information. Senior hours can be documented by picking up the forms in the guidance office and filling them out correctly (i.e. description of volunteerism, date hours served, and parent signature). Completed senior hour forms need to be turned into the student’s individual guidance counselor.
