Coach's Comments:

Tigers Pound Raiders for First Home Victory - The Fishers football team defeated the Harrison Raiders in the Homecoming game to capture the Tigers' first home victory with a score of 34-15. Zach Hoke rushed for 128 yards including a 55 yard touchdown and threw for 127 yards to lead the Tiger offense. Matt Hitt caught 7 passes for 122 yards, and Joel Kinsey caught a 5 touchdown pass from Hoke. Nico Walker added 2 touchdown runs and Nick Easter scored one as the Tigers rolled up over 450 yards of total offense. Brodie Kalbaugh led the defense with 5 solo tackles, 7 assists, and 1 sack. Phil Stamm added 6 solos and 2 assists while Mark Balaszek tallied 2 solos and 7 assisted tackles. The defense created 2 turnovers with Nick Oudin's fumble recovery and an interception by Matt Hitt. The Tigers return home next Friday as they host the McCutcheon Mavericks.
