Fishers High School opened in the Fall of 2006 with grades 9 through 11 in enrollment, expanding beyond its previous three years as a freshmen campus for Hamilton Southeastern High School. In the Fall of 2007 the school enrolled grades 9-12 and quickly grew into a 2000+ student body competing at the 4-A level in the Indiana High School Athletic Association (IHSAA). Fishers High School is part of the Hamilton Southeastern School District and is a member of the highly competitive Hoosier Crossroads Conference which consists of the following schools: Avon, Brownsburg, Fishers, Harrison (Lafayette), Jefferson (Lafayette), McCutcheon (Lafayette), Noblesville, Southeastern (Fishers), Westfield, and Zionsville.

The Tigers run a K-12 program with clinics, travel leagues, and recreational leagues offered to youth players. At the high school level, the program uses freshmen, junior varsity, and varsity squads to provide opportunities for interested participants. The committed young athletes in the program participate in off-season training during the spring, summer, and fall in preparation for athletic competition. The program has several multi-sport athletes as well as players that participate in AAU basketball for various AAU programs on the north side of Indy. These ladies balance their athletic commitments with challenging academics at one of the most rigorous and accomplished high schools in the nation.
