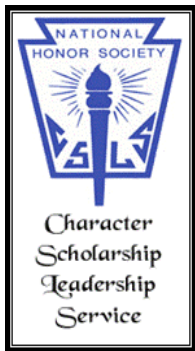

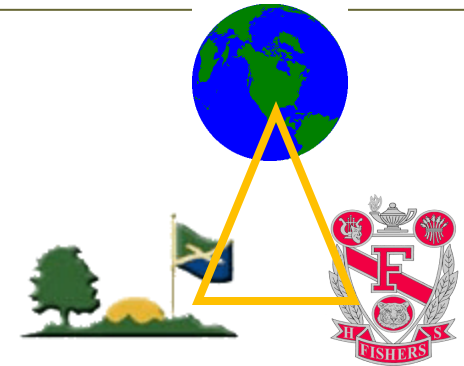
How does one qualify for National Honor Society Membership?

Sophomores and juniors who have been students in the Hamilton Southeastern School Corporation for at least one semester and have a grade point average (GPA) of 3.33 or better are eligible to apply for membership into the Fishers High School Chapter of the National Honor Society. All eligible prospective members will be given the opportunity to apply for membership, but eligibility does not guarantee acceptance.

REQUIREMENTS:

- 3.33 GPA
- 10 documented hours of community service
- Membership and/or leadership roles in 3 FHS organizations

This is an honor bestowed upon candidates who show outstanding character, service to the Fishers community and leadership as determined by the NHS faculty committee.



What are the expectations for National Honor Society members?

National Honor Society members are expected to be enthusiastic about scholarship, be willing to take on leadership roles in the school and community, approach problems and obstacles with a strong sense of morals, values and character, as well as have a desire to render service.
