## COACH MORIARITY CAMP DIRECTOR



Coach Moriarity was the offensive line coach for the Indiana Hoosiers during the 2010 season helping them become the #1 pass offense in the Big Ten. The offensive line gave up 1 sack per 42.75 attempts which was the best in the Big Ten Conference and allowed a total of 12 sacks for the year which ranked #15 nationally. Coach Moriarity was head coach at Carmel high school from 2005 – 2009 leading the Greyhounds to four consecutive state title games and winning it all in 2007. Coach Moriarity won state championships at Bloomington South high school in 1993 and 1998. His won – loss record is 241 wins and 56 losses that include eight undefeated seasons and twelve conference championships. He was head coach of the South All-Stars in 1994 and served as president of the Indiana Football Coaches Association in 1998. He has coached three Mr. Football award winners including Bo Barzilauskas (lineman '93), Rex Grossman (QB' 98) and Morgan Newton (QB' 08).

### CAMP OUTLINE

#### OFFENSE:

Centers, Guards, Tackles and TE's

Run Blocking: stance and starts, drive, reach, gap cut-off, scoop, zone, LB blocks, double team blocks, combo blocks, trap and pulling

Pass Protection: pass set, pass sets from different starting positions, pass sets vs. different alignments, punch, hands and feet

TE's: run blocking, stance and starts, drive, reach, gap, zone, double team, combo and block secondary support

Passing Game: releases, route running, pass receiving, and coverage recognition

#### DEFENSE:

Noseguards, Tackles and Defensive Ends

Stance and starts, use of hand, disengagement, gap control, slant technique, pass rush and reading keys
