You may also access a list of classes that are offered at HSE that will count per NCAA Clearinghouse requirements on this site. The website is www.ncaaclearinghouse.net. All Juniors should plan on taking the SAT THIS spring, see your counselor for more information.

Grades and Academics

SAT: All juniors should take the SAT or ACT in the spring and the first time that it is offered in the fall. See you counselor today. You have to sign up approximately 3 weeks before the exam. **PLAN AHEAD!**
