

The Royals JV broke in the new turf at HSE with a 21 - 6 victory over Avon on Monday night. Darius Mosely opened the scoring in the 2nd quarter with a 5 yard touchdown run. In the 3rd quarter, the Royals' defense put up a score when Randy Gregory hit Avon's QB as he was throwing, leading to an 18-yd interception return for a touchdown by Enrique Guajardo. The Royals capped off their scoring on a 68 yard touchdown pass from David Cheslyn to Brandon Sink. The Royals return to action on Tuesday when they travel to Fishers. Game time is 6 pm.

The Royals JV football team endured nearly 90 minutes of lightning delays to defeat Fishers last night by a score of 35 - 19. Leading 14 - 13 midway through the 3rd quarter and driving deep into Tiger territory, the Royals' offense was forced off the field by a second lightning delay. When play resumed, the Royals put the Tigers away by scoring 21 unanswered points.

Quarterback David Cheslyn scored three touchdowns on the evening on a 42 yard run and a pair of 3 yard runs. Tailback Aaron Hall ran the ball well all night and scored on a 4 yard touchdown. Fullback Michael Dorman capped the scoring for the Royals with a 64 yard touchdown run. The Royals defense played very well, limiting the Tigers running game and pressuring their passing attack. The Royals host Brownsburg next Monday night.
