Save the date – Kindergarten Round-Up set for Feb. 9, 2012

Hamilton Southeastern Schools will host Kindergarten Round-Up earlier than usual this year on Thursday, February 9, 2012. A child must be 5 years of age before **September 1, 2012**, in order to register for kindergarten for the **2012 - 2013 school year**. Pre-registration packet pickup dates started January 18 and will continue through February 1, 2012 from 11:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m. daily.

When you pick up a packet or come to round-up you should bring:

- Your child's birth certificate
- A copy of their immunizations
- Guardianship paper (if applicable)
- 3 forms of Proof of Residency - You can see the HSE website (www.hse.k12.in.us, District Information, Enrolling your child, and Step 3) for a list of what is needed.

Examples for Proof of Residency from each column are:

- Lease, closing papers or mortgage payment stub
- Utility bill (gas, electric, water, sewer or phone)
- Driver's license, current vehicle registration, or valid Indiana photo I.D.

The list of required immunizations is available on the HSE web site (www.hse.k12.in.us) by following the "Parent Portal," looking under "More Online Services" and clicking on "Health Services." A chart of required immunizations for each grade level is available there.

In addition, parents can find the school their child will attend by clicking on "Enrollment Overview," "Enroll in Elementary School" and look for "Determining Your Child's School."

HSE will make information available about next year's full-day kindergarten opportunities as soon as those plans are finalized.

Procedure for Reporting Absences



Each day that your child is absent, a parent needs to call the school before 9:00 a.m. to report the absence. Messages can be left on the school's answering machine in the evening or early morning hours. This procedure should also be followed whenever your child is going to be tardy for any reason (i.e. doctor or dentist appointment). We are required to account for all students, so if we do not hear from a parent, we will attempt to contact you to be sure that your child is safe and where he/she is supposed to be. If your child is going to be absent for two or more days for non-medical reasons, please contact the office for a pre-arranged absence form.
