- Ask their child what the main idea or message of a book might be.

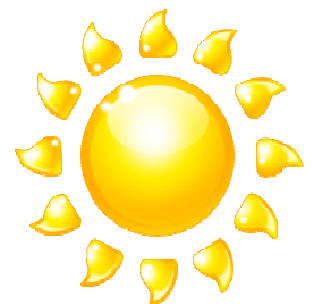
