Student Attendance & Absences

Student attendance at SCIS is vitally important. Please make every attempt possible to plan appointments and vacations outside of school hours. Regular attendance improves student performance and is expected as an integral part of our state mandated School Improvement Plan. If your child will be absent from school, please call the attendance line by 9:00am at 915-4234.

If a student is absent two or more consecutive days, parents may call the attendance line (by 9:00am) on the morning of the second day of absence to request homework. Homework can be picked up after school. The office is open until 3:45pm.

Hamilton Southeastern Schools attendance policy states that absences from school for more than 16 school days in a school year requires the submission of a doctor's note for any further absences to be deemed excused. Unexcused absences may result in poor or failing grades and will definitely result in escalating disciplinary consequences for non-compliance.
