



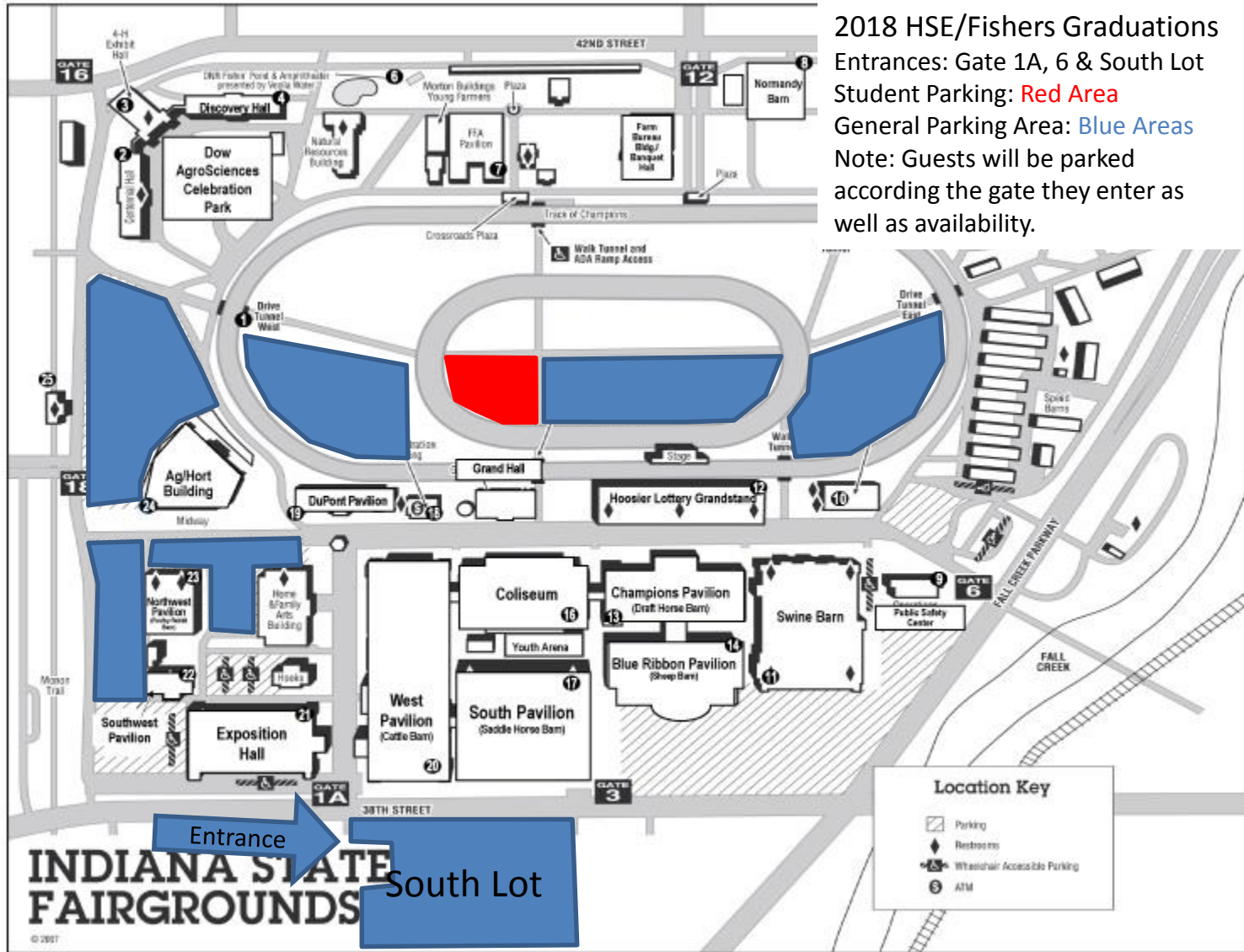
Class of 2018 Senior Activities and Commencement Information

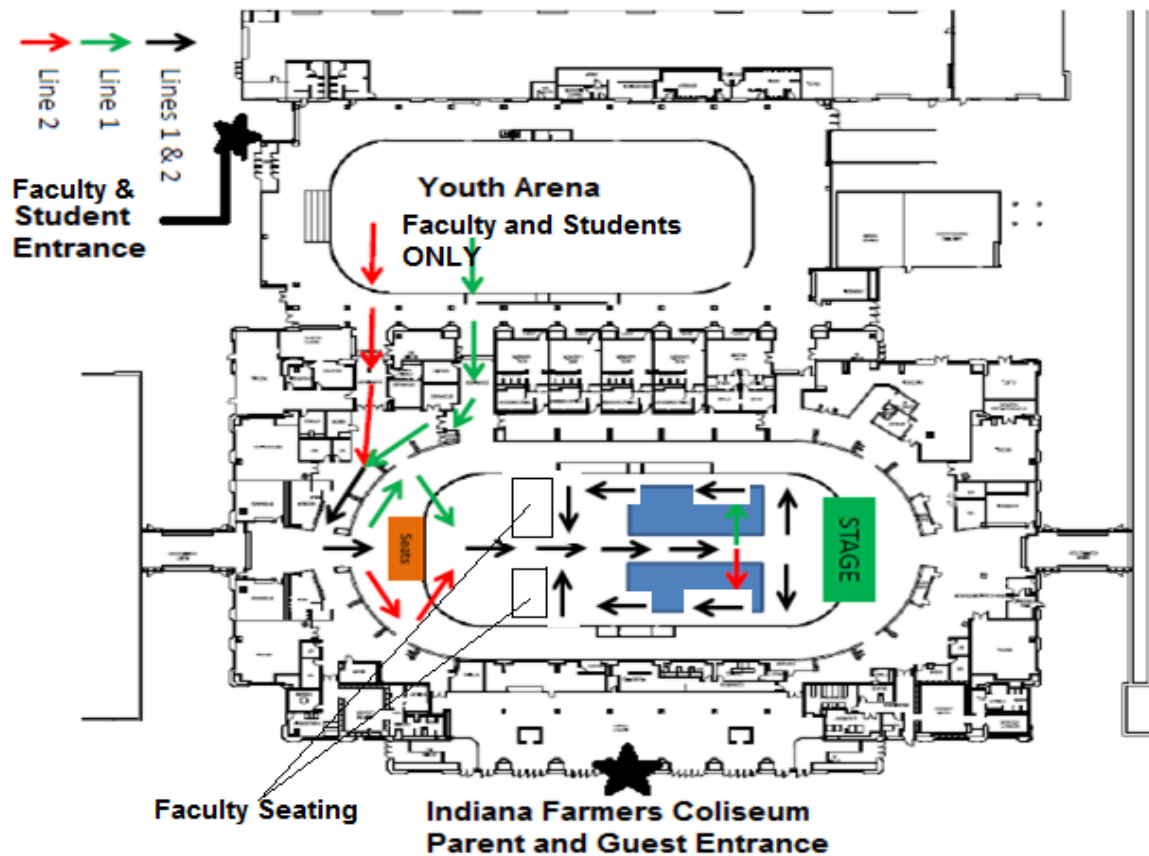
Date	June 2, 2018
Time	3:00 PM – Doors will open at 1:30 PM
Location	<p>Indiana Farmers Coliseum, Indiana State Fairgrounds</p> <p>HHS Students must arrive at the Coliseum and be in the Youth Arena by 2:15 PM. Only graduating seniors will be able to enter the Youth Arena.</p> <p>Parents and all other guests will enter the Coliseum through the main entrance. Fairground personnel will direct guests to the Coliseum seating area. There are no assigned seats. All seating is on a first come basis.</p> <p>All persons entering the Coliseum or Youth Arena will go through the Indiana State Fairgrounds metal detectors.</p>
Handicapped Seating	Handicapped seating will be available in the designated ADA areas. Each person requiring handicapped seating will be allowed one companion to remain with them during the commencement ceremony.
Parking	<p>Parking will be available for students and guests for \$5.00 per vehicle. Cash and credit cards are accepted. Parking attendants will direct you to the closest spaces. ADA parking is available.</p> <p>Indiana Farmer’s Coliseum and State Fairgrounds Parking Maps are included on the last page of this document.</p>
Dress Code	<p>For ladies, a dress, skirt, or dress pants are suitable. For gentlemen, a shirt, tie and dress pants are appropriate. No flip-flops, tennis shoes, or jeans permitted.</p> <p>Seniors wearing inappropriate attire will not be allowed to participate in graduation. After commencement has concluded students and parents will reunite outside of the Youth Arena.</p>
Tickets	<p>Each student will receive eight tickets. If you need more than eight, please have your student network with friends and classmates. If you are unable to get more tickets, please submit a request in writing to Mr. Kegley no later than May 18, 2018.</p> <p>Small children under the age of three that can sit on a lap do not need a ticket.</p>
Senior Activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Senior Breakfast – Friday, June 1st in the Cafeteria beginning at 10:00 AM • Senior Program – Friday, June 1st in the Leonard Auditorium, starting at approximately 11:00 AM

Commencement Rehearsal	<p>ALL STUDENTS WILL BE BUSED TO COMMENCEMENT REHEARSAL</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Friday, June 1st 2. Load buses at 11:45 AM, depart HHS no later than noon 3. Arrive at Indiana Farmers Coliseum and begin rehearsal by 1:00 PM 4. Rehearsal finishes about 3:30 PM 5. Students are back to HHS at approximately 4:30 PM <p>NOTE: Rehearsal is mandatory for all students walking at Commencement. Transportation to and from the State Fairgrounds will be provided for rehearsal. Reminder: All students must ride the buses.</p>
Commencement Transportation	<p>Students are permitted to drive to the Commencement Ceremony.</p>
How long is Commencement?	<p>The Commencement ceremony usually lasts about two hours.</p>
Turning in caps and gowns	<p>Caps and gowns will be turned in immediately after the Commencement ceremony has concluded as the students return to the Youth Arena</p>
Commencement Pictures	<p>Please plan to take pictures of your student in their cap and gown prior to Commencement. Once students enter the stadium to report for line-up they will not see their families until after the ceremony.</p> <p>Prestige portraits will have pictures of Commencement available on their website. The web address will be listed on the back of the Commencement Program.</p>
