RE: Textbooks for dual credit courses taught at Hamilton Southeastern High School

Dear Parent(s) or Guardian(s):

For next school year, your son or daughter has signed up to take one or more dual credit courses through Indiana University, Ball State University, or Ivy Tech Community College. These courses provide students the opportunity to challenge themselves academically and to earn college credits for free or at a substantially reduced cost.

Each year, the respective advising college professors inform our teachers of the requirements for the class in regards to curriculum, textbooks, and assessments. Our teachers must follow these curriculum guidelines, use the assigned textbooks, and give the created assessments. Due to this ever-changing course requirements process, Hamilton Southeastern High School has had to adjust its textbook rental procedures for students taking dual credit courses.

In short, your student will need to acquire the appropriate textbook(s) for the course(s) they have signed up for on their own.

As with all college courses, many options are available for your student:

- Your student can buy a new textbook (and possibly resell it at the end of the course).
- Your student can buy a used textbook if the required edition is available.
- Your student can rent and download digital versions of the textbook if available. **(Make sure the rental period is sufficient to cover the semester(s) your student will have the course.)**

Please assist your student in acquiring the required textbook(s) as soon as possible. However, if you choose to rent, you may want to wait until August when you know your student's specific schedule. This will ensure that the rental period covers the correct semester. Use the chart from the enclosed document to order textbooks, paying particular attention to the **ISBN Number** to ensure you have the correct edition.

In those cases in which students qualify for Free or Reduced Lunch, and thus textbook assistance, the parent/guardian/student should contact Mrs. Timmons, Bookstore Manager, as soon as possible. Mrs. Timmons will ensure your student will have access to the appropriate textbooks.
