Tickets will be sold at **ONE table this year located between lunchrooms**. Tickets will be sold at **the bookstore during normal school hours**. Tickets **will not be sold in the bookstore during lunches**.

1. Students do not need a student I.D. to purchase tickets but **MUST HAVE** their HSE Student I.D. at the door.
 - a. A picture of the HSE Student I.D. on their phone is acceptable.
 - b. Replacement student I.D.'s may be purchased in the Media Center several days in advance.
 - c. We cannot guarantee the ability to look a student up on Skyward. Please, bring your HSE Student I.D.
2. Cash or Checks only. Checks made out to **HSE High School**. *There is a return check fee for anyone who writes a check with insufficient funds.*
3. HSE Students may purchase tickets for other HSE students.
4. **Tickets are NON-REFUNDABLE and NON-TRANSFERABLE.**
5. **Tickets are sold on a first-come, first-served basis and could sell out. We will have 1200 tickets available.**
6. **Students must purchase the tickets themselves.** Parents may not purchase tickets for their students.

Rules for bringing a guest from Fishers High School:

1. If an HSE student wishes to bring a guest from FHS, you do not need a guest application.
2. The FHS student **will need his/her ID at the entrance to prom**.
3. FHS students are only allowed to come as a guest of an HSE student and may not purchase tickets on their own.

Rules for bringing a guest from another school:

1. If a student wished to bring a guest from a school other than HSE, the HSE student must obtain a Dance Guest Form from the Deans' Office or the CCA.

NOTE: All of the following rules/criteria are on the Dance Guest Form

- a. The form is to be taken to the guest's school administration to be completed and returned.
 - b. The form must have a copy of the guest's I.D. attached to it.
 - c. Students may not be older than 20 to attend.
 - d. If the student is not in school, they must prove they have graduated from high school or show an ID from a current college.
 - e. All of those guest forms get turned into the HSE host student's dean for final approval.
 - f. The original form must be completed and returned.
 - g. We will accept email or fax from the other school (not the student)
 - h. HSE will not fax or email the form for the HSE student to the guest's school
2. Once the guest has been approved, the HSE Student will receive a Guest Voucher and may then purchase a ticket for the guest at the current price.
 3. The **Guest Voucher is NOT a ticket**.
 4. **No HSE student will be sold a ticket for a guest without the Guest Voucher.**

Prom FAQ Sheet

Entrance into Prom

1. **Everyone must have an I.D. to get into the dance.**
2. HSE/FHS students may use a clear picture of their student I.D. on their cellphones if they don't wish to carry it to prom.
3. Replacement I.D.s are sold in the media center. Please allow sufficient time to get a new I.D.
4. Students from other schools or other guest may use their driver's licenses.
5. Students **need their tickets to enter prom.**
